



POINT HELIDECK VISUAL AIDS PROHIBITED LANDING SIGNAL FOR MARINE HELIDECKS

Gulf of Mexico Helideck Markings

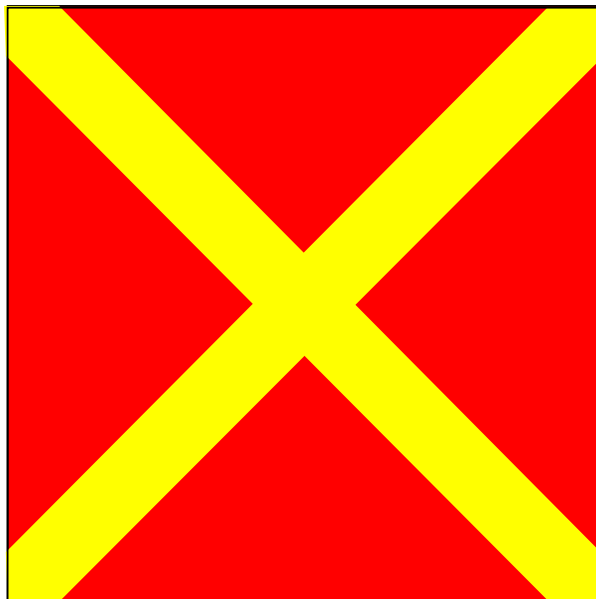
For certain operational or technical reasons an installation may have to prohibit helicopter operations. In such circumstances, where the helideck cannot be used, the "closed" state of the helideck should be indicated by use of the signal shown below. This signal is the standard "landing prohibited" signal given in the UK Rules of the Air and Air Traffic Control Regulations, except that it has been altered in size to just cover the letter "H" inside the TD/PM circle (aiming circle).

SPECIFICATION

Heavy-duty square red reinforced vinyl fabric marker with a stitched yellow "X" per CAP 437 2012. Overall dimensions 4000 mm by 4000 mm with the yellow lines 500 mm wide. Marine grade tie down grommets (tie down straps by others) ten (10) per side evenly spaced.
